<p>REGISTRATION FEES TUITION FEES (Non-refundable) AND STUDY REQUIREMENTS (Mandatory)</p> <p>PAYMENTS:</p> <p>MAKE PAYMENTS TO HIGH POINT BALLET</p> <p>Tuition may be paid in full or by monthly auto-draft on a credit or debit card. (Multiple children discount applies only to payment in full). Payments in full qualify for a 5% discount, with the exception of production and summer tuition fees, and is due April 15th for the 17-18 season. Monthly payments are due on the 1st, past due on the 5th and subject to a \$35 late fee after the 5th. Monthly fees not on auto-draft still require credit or debit card information on file as fees not received by the 5th will be processed through this card. Upon enrollment, financial responsibility is assumed for all fees for the current term which includes Summer 2017 and 2017-2018 Season tuition, Nutcracker and Spring production fees, and membership fees regardless of early withdrawal. All costumes are to remain in the theater until the final performance's completion. Should any costume item be lost, damaged, or misplaced in the theater, the performer is responsible for any additional cost of replacement incurred. Unless otherwise designated, all costumes and/or accessories are the property of Taylor Dance and are to be returned directly to the costuming staff before leaving the theater.</p> <p>Performers are responsible for personal items such as shoes, tights, makeup, hair supplies, and applicable undergarments. PROCESS	A panel of dance experts, including the Director(s) of the High Point Ballet, will adjudicate the High Point Ballet auditions. It is important to understand the adjudication process is subjective. The auditions will begin as close to the designated time as possible. The adjudication process begins as soon as the dancer walks onto the dance floor. No parents, guardians, or caretakers will be allowed in the audition studio. Adjudicators will observe each dancer as they perform a variety of movements. Results of the audition, which is the placement level beginning this summer, will be distributed in a timely manner.

General Release/Indemnification Form

In case of an emergency, if the staff of the High Point Ballet is unable to reach me by phone, concerning a situation that requires immediate emergency medical assistance, I hereby give my permission to the staff to secure treatment for my child as named in this application. As an additional consideration for the student's membership, the undersigned hereby releases High Point Ballet from liability for injuries to the person or property of the student, which may occur while participating in the activities of this company. The undersigned further agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, release and forever discharge High Point Ballet, its Board of Directors, officers, employees, volunteers, performers, participants and its successors in the event any claims are asserted against it arising from the student's participation in the activities of this company. Furthermore, I will not hold High Point Ballet responsible for any theft, accident or injury during any High Point Ballet function or activity.
